**RESOLUTION NO. 2024-08-03**  
**RESOLUTION ADOPTING TRANSPORTATION PLAN PURSUANT**  
**TO REBUILD ALABAMA ACT (ACT 2019-2)**

**WHEREAS**, the 2019 Alabama Legislature has passed an HB2 to levy additional excise tax on gasoline and diesel fuel; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Town of Woodstock is to receive a portion of said tax based on the ratio of population of each municipality to the total population of all municipalities of the state; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Town of Woodstock pledges to keep this money in separate funds and expend only for maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of roads and as mandated by the law passed; and,


**WHEREAS**, the Act provides that the Town of Woodstock shall adopt an annual Transportation Plan no later than August 31 for the fiscal year 2025 based on an estimate of revenues.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Council of the Town of Woodstock estimates that its anticipated allocation from the Rebuild Alabama Act fund for the Fiscal Year 2025 will be approximately \$29,000.00, with the increasing allocations for each fiscal year thereafter. The Town of Woodstock also received a Rebuild Alabama Act Annual Grant (RAA) in the amount of \$250,000.00. Pursuant to the Act, the Town anticipates expending funds received pursuant to the Act, in part or in whole, for street maintenance, improvement, replacement and construction of the following roads within the Town of Woodstock: Dream Lake Road, Reno Camp Road, County Road 12, Shamblin Woods Road, Giles Road, Gabrielle Drive and Laura Lane.




